Chopin Warsaw Airport [WAW] - 20-25 min with taxi or public transport to/form centre Hotels:

Blu Radisson - close by the BlueSoft HQ Radisson Blu Sobieski Hotel, Warsaw InterContinental - the most iconic hotel view in Warsaw InterContinental Warsaw, an IHG Hotel

There are plenty of hotels in the centre of the city which are clean, well situated and in the resale price, what I would discourage are hotels near the Old town, lots of noise and relatively long commute.

Transportation around city:

Public transport - reliable, clean and operates long hours, tickets can be bought in buses, trams and at entrances of metro stations https://www.wtp.waw.pl/en/public-transport-step-by-step/

Taxi: I would recommend using mobile apps, there are very few of the taxi stations around the city. Uber and Bolt are also available.

Car: I would highly discourage you to rent a car to travel around Warsaw, the driving culture in Warsaw is quite specific and parking can be expensive and hard to find.
